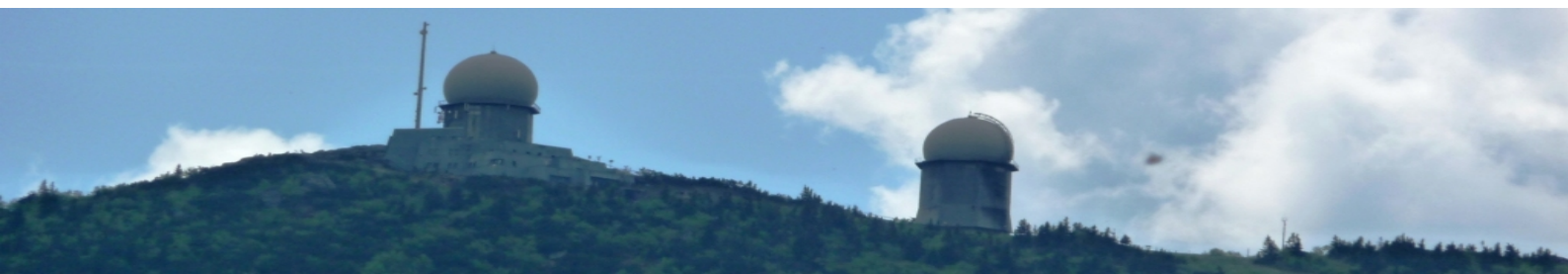

By registering for the tournament, the player automatically agrees to the utilisation by the responsible authorities of data and scores resulting from the tournament for the generation of DWZ and FIDE ratings as well as with the publication of games, photos, tournament data, game reports and the like.

By registering for the tournament, players recognize the statutes of the German Chess Association (Deutscher Schachbund e.V. / DSB) as valid and binding for their participation. Basic principles defined by the DSB's statutes include the promotion of fair play in competitive chess and the combat against direct or indirect use illicit technical aids. In the case of a transgression, participants subject themselves to the sanctioning powers of the DSB, in particular to measures stated under §§ 55 to 61 of the DSB's statutes, and to the Chess Association's jurisdiction.

Players who are currently suspended or barred by the FIDE, the DSB or by a member association of the DSB will be barred from participation in the tournament. Moreover, the tournament host reserves the right to bar players from participation when there are reasons to believe that they did not abide by the rules of a previous tournament or competition as well as the right to expel players with immediate effect from the tournament if their behaviour during the tournament gives cause to suspect a breach of the rules.
